



## 20<sup>th</sup> Al Acker One Day Championship

### **General Information:**

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the CSGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

### **Face Covering:**

The CSGA asks that you always keep a face covering accessible to you. Please be advised that Shennecossett Golf Course requires the use of a face covering when entering the Pro Shop or Par 4 Restaurant.

### **Schedule of Events:**

Tuesday, October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021 – The format will be 18 holes of stroke play with both gross and net tournaments. All players have been placed in the division that they qualified in, Siderowf (Senior) division or Tettelbach (Open) division.

### **Grouping & Starting Times:**

Tuesday, October 5<sup>th</sup>, 2021 – The shotgun start will begin at 9:00am.

### **Traffic Conditions:**

Traffic on all major highways in this area of Connecticut is extremely heavy throughout the day, especially during morning hours. Please adjust your departure time to accommodate the traffic conditions.

### **Practice Round:**

Practice rounds are available at the player's expense through the Shennecossett Golf Shop at (860) 448-1867.

### **Registration:**

Players must check in at the player registration table located directly in front of the golf shop upon their arrival.

### **Practice Range:**

There is no practice range available at Shennecossett Golf Course. East Lyme Driving Range will be opening early at 7:30am for players who wish to practice prior to the round. The driving range is located at 298 Flanders Road, East Lyme (12 miles from Shennecossett). The phone number for the East Lyme Driving Range is (860) 449-3424. Practice on the golf course in advance of the round will not be allowed and offenders of this policy will be disqualified.

### **Caddies & Transportation:**

Golf carts are mandatory for this event and the cost of the cart is included in your entry fee. In keeping with the One Day tournament policies, caddies are not allowed for this event.

### **Attire:**

Proper golf attire is required at all times by players, caddies and spectators. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

### **Footwear:**

Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during the stipulated round. See Model Local Rule G-7.

The winners and runners-up in each division will receive an engraved CSGA One Day Championship trophy mailed to their home. Top finishers in each division will receive merchandise credit and Chris Cote's Golf Shop will award gift cards to the top three Players of the Year in the season long divisional contests.

### Withdrawals:

You must contact the CSGA at (860) 257-4171 if you must withdraw from this championship. A competitor who fails to notify the CSGA of his withdrawal may be subject to disciplinary actions.
