Face Covering:

The CSGA asks that you always keep a face covering accessible to you as many indoor spaces may require their use.

General Information:

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the CSGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

Schedule of Events:

Monday, August 16th – 18 holes of stroke play. Players with the low 30 scores, including ties, will advance to round two.
Tuesday, August 17th – 18 holes of stroke play. The player with the lowest 36-hole total will be declared champion.

Practice Round:

Practice rounds are available at the H. Smith Richardson Golf Course published rates and times.

Registration:

Players must check in at the player registration table located outside the golf shop upon their arrival.

Practice Range:

The practice range will be available beginning at 6:30am. **PLEASE NOTE:** The practice range is not located on the same property as the golf course. The range is less than a two-minute drive from the course but does require access via car. You are not permitted to take a golf cart to the range.

Caddies:

The use of a caddie is permitted. H. Smith Richardson does not have any club caddies.

Golf Carts:

Players may use a golf cart however the cost of a golf cart is not included in the entry fee. Players must arrange for payment of the cart with the golf shop staff. There are limited golf carts and players may be required to share a cart. There will only be two carts allowed per starting time.

Attire:

Proper golf attire is required at all times by players, caddies and spectators. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

Footwear:

Rule 4.3a is modified in this way: During a round, a player must not wear shoes with traditional spikes (that is, spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground (regardless of whether made of metal, ceramic, plastic, or other materials)) or spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course.

Course Setup:

H. Smith Richards Golf Course will play as a par 72 at approximately 6,700 yards with a time par of 4 hours and 24 minutes.

Trophies & Prizes:

The winner will have his name engraved on the permanent Public Links Championship trophy. Top finishers will receive merchandise credit redeemable at H. Smith Richardson Golf Course.

Withdrawals:

You must contact the CSGA at (860) 257-4171 if you must withdraw from this championship. A competitor who fails to notify the CSGA of his withdrawal may be subject to disciplinary actions.
