Face Covering:

The CSGA asks that you always keep a face covering accessible to you. Please be advised that the Town of Fairfield has enacted an indoor mask requirement regardless of vaccination status. All persons will be required to wear a face covering when entering the clubhouse or pro shop areas.

General Information:

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the USGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

Schedule of Events:

Monday, September 27th – 18 holes of stroke play. Cut to the low 39 scores (including ties).

Tuesday, September 28th – 18 holes of stroke play.

Play-Off & Ties:

In the event of a tie for the championship, there will be a sudden death hole by hole playoff immediately following the conclusion of round two.

Practice Round:

Practice rounds are available on a limited basis on the following dates: September 15, 16 & 21. The cost of a practice round is \$50 and arrangements can be made by contacting a member of the professional staff at (203) 255-2121.

Registration:

Players must check in at the player registration table located in front of the golf shop upon their arrival.

Practice Range:

The practice range will be available for use beginning one hour prior to play each day. The cost of the practice range is included in your entry fee.

Caddies & Transportation:

The use of a golf cart is mandatory and included as part of your entry fee. Caddies are permitted but may be required to walk.

Attire:

Proper golf attire is required at all times by players, caddies and spectators. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

Footwear:

Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during the stipulated round. See Model Local Rule G-7.



Driver Heads & Golf Balls:

Only brands of golf balls on the most current List of Conforming Golf Balls and driver heads on the most current List of Conforming Driver Heads may be used. Updated lists may be found on the USGA website at www.usga.org or by contacting the USGA Equipment Standards Department at (908) 234-2300. See Model Local Rules G-1 and G-3.

Food & Beverage:

Lunch will be provided for contestants each day of the Championship and is included in your entry fee.

Trophies & Prizes:

The winner will have his name engraved on the permanent Connecticut Senior Amateur trophy. The winner and runner-up will also receive a replica trophy. Also, low finishers will receive merchandise credit redeemable at The Patterson Club golf shop. Ties for any position other than Champion will be decided by round two total first then by a match of cards using round two.

Withdrawals:

You must contact the CSGA at (860) 257-4171 if you must withdraw from this championship. A competitor who fails to notify the CSGA of his withdrawal may be subject to disciplinary actions.
