



NOTICE TO PLAYERS
CSGA One Day Tournament
Mill River Country Club
Monday, July 19, 2021



This notice to players supplements the CSGA Local Rules and Conditions of Competitions, which may be found on the Mill River One Day tournament portal.

PACE OF PLAY: The CSGA Pace of Play policy will be in effect for this One Day event. Players are expected to complete their round in 4 and a half hours. Please play "ready golf" as outlined in the 2019 Rules of Golf. Players may be apprised of their pace of play periodically by on-course officials.

FORMAT: 18-hole stroke play with gross and net competitions in divisions, Tettelbach (Open) and Siderowf (Senior).

FLIGHTS: All players age fifty-five (55) and older are competing in the Siderowf (Senior) division with the remaining players are in the Tettelbach (Open) division. The July 19th Handicap Revision will be used for all handicap purposes.

TEES: Tettelbach (Open) Division – **Gold Tees**
Siderowf (Senior) Division – **Blue Tees** - Gross and Net **or Green Forward Tees** – Net Only Competition

SCORING: All scoring will be done through the Golf Genius Mobile Scoring App. Each group will receive a unique GGID which will be used to enter scores throughout the round. All players need to proceed to the scoring table after the completion of play to verbally certify your score with a member of the CSGA staff. This verbal certification process is equivalent to signing your scorecard.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Identified or defined by boundary fences, white stakes and/or lines on the following holes:
Hole #1 and Hole #10 – the ball must be over the stone wall to be out of bounds.
Hole #11 and Hole #14 – the fence left of the tee and fairway defines out of bounds.
Hole #9 and #18 - the parking lot behind the green is out of bounds.

PENALTY AREAS: Identified by yellow or red stakes and/or lines on hole #12 and the left side of hole #15. In addition, tall grasses off to the right side of the 2nd and 3rd tees, 13th green and left side of the 16th tee are penalty areas. When both stakes and lines are present, stakes identify the penalty area and lines define the penalty area. Relief is available as described in Rule 17-1.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Areas defined by white lines on the ground are considered to be Ground Under Repair. Free relief is available as prescribed in Rule 16-1. Areas with wood chips are *not* ground under repair and there is no free relief.

NO PLAY ZONES: Flower beds are considered no play zones and free relief is *mandatory* as detailed in Rule 16.

PRIZES: Top finishers in each division will receive merchandise credit redeemable at the Mill River C.C. Golf Shop. Additionally, the top five finishers in each division will qualify to be eligible for the season ending One Day Championship at Shennecossett Golf Course on October 5th.

ONE DAY PLAYER OF THE YEAR SPONSORED BY CHRIS COTE'S GOLF SHOP: The top fifteen finishers in the Tettelbach and Siderowf divisions earn One Day Tournament Player of the Year points. One Day Players may receive points in both the gross and net division. The top three finishers in each division at the end of the year will receive merchandise credit redeemable at Chris Cote's Golf Shop in Portland, Conn.
