



NOTICE TO PLAYERS
CSGA One Day Tournament
Manchester Country Club
Monday, Sept. 13, 2021



This notice to players supplements the CSGA Local Rules and Terms of Competitions, which may be found on the Manchester C.C. One Day tournament portal.

PACE OF PLAY: The CSGA Pace of Play policy will be in effect for this One Day event. Players are expected to complete their round in 4 and a half hours. Please play "ready golf" as outlined in the 2019 Rules of Golf.

FORMAT: 18-hole Four-Ball with gross and net categories in both divisions.

FLIGHTS: All teams have been placed in either the Siderowf (Senior) division or Tettelbach (Open) division. The Sept. 13th Handicap Revision will be used for all handicap purposes.

TEES: Tettelbach (Open) Division – **Blue Tees** Siderowf (Senior) Division – **White Tees**

SCORING: All scoring will be done through the Golf Genius Mobile Scoring App. Each group will receive a unique GGID which will be used to enter scores throughout the round. Please proceed to the scoring table immediately after the completion of play. Scores must be verbally certified by a member of the CSGA staff.

PENALTY AREAS: Identified or defined by red stakes and/or lines on the following holes: 1, 7, 9, 10, 11, 12, 14, 15, 16, 18

OUT OF BOUNDS: Identified or defined by boundary fences, white stakes and/or lines on the following holes: 1, 2, 3, 4, 6, 9, 13, 14, 17, 18

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Areas defined by white lines or white ropes are considered to be Ground Under Repair. Free relief is available as prescribed in Rule 16.

NO PLAY ZONES: Nurseries on holes #14 & #15 are deemed to be no play zones and free relief is mandatory.

PRIZES: Top team finishers in each division will receive merchandise credit redeemable at the Manchester Country Club. Additionally, the top five team finishers in each division will qualify to be eligible for the season ending One Day Championship at Shennecossett Golf Club on October 5th.

ONE DAY PLAYER OF THE YEAR SPONSORED BY CHRIS COTE'S GOLF SHOP: The top fifteen teams in each division will earn One Day Tournament Player of the Year points. Players may receive points in both the gross and net division. The top three finishers in each division at the end of the year will receive merchandise credit redeemable at Chris Cote's Golf Shop in Portland, Connecticut.
