



NOTICE TO PLAYERS
20th Al Acker One Day Championship
Shennecossett Golf Course
Tuesday, October 5, 2021



This notice to players supplements the CSGA Local Rules and Terms of Competitions, which may be found at the One Day Championship Portal.

PACE OF PLAY: The CSGA Pace of Play policy will be in effect for this One Day Championship. Players are expected to complete their round in 4 and a half hours. Please play "ready golf" as outlined in the 2019 Rules of Golf.

FORMAT: 18-hole stroke play with both gross and net tournaments in each division.

FLIGHTS: All teams have been placed in either the Siderowf (Senior) division or Tettelbach (Open) division that they qualified in. The October 5th Handicap Revision will be used for all handicap purposes.

TEES: Tettelbach (Open) Division – **Blue Tees** Siderowf (Senior) Division – **White Tees**

SCORING: All scoring will be done through the Golf Genius Mobile Scoring App. Each group will receive a unique GGID which will be used to enter scores throughout the round. Please proceed to the scoring area immediately after the completion of play. Scores will be verbally certified by a member of the CSGA staff.

PENALTY AREAS: Identified or defined by red or yellow stakes and lines. When both stakes and lines are present, the stakes define the type of hazard and the lines define the margin of the hazard.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Identified or defined by boundary fences, white stakes and/or lines. All shots beyond the golf course property are considered out of bounds including the parking lot from holes #9 & #18.

ENVIRONMENTALLY SENSITIVE AREAS: These No Play Zone areas are defined by *red stakes with green tops*. If your ball lies inside the no play zone, *free relief is mandatory* as prescribed under Rule 16-1. If your ball lies outside the no play zone and the no play zone interferes with your stance or area of intended swing, you must take free relief as detailed in Rule 16-1(f).

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Areas defined by white lines or white ropes are considered to be Ground Under Repair. Free relief is available as prescribed in Rule 16.

PRIZES: Top finishers in each division will receive merchandise credit and the winner and runner-up in each division will receive an engraved 20th Al Acker One Day Championship trophy mailed to their home.

ONE DAY PLAYER OF THE YEAR SPONSORED BY CHRIS COTE'S GOLF SHOP: The top fifteen individuals in each division will earn One Day Championship Player of the Year points. Players may receive points in both the gross and net categories, but can only win in one category. The top three finishers in each division following the Championship will receive gift card prizes at our awards ceremony redeemable at any Chris Cote's Golf Shop location.
