THIS NOTICE TO PLAYERS SUPPLEMENTS THE CSGA LOCAL RULES AND CONDITIONS CARD AND THE LETTER TO CONTESTANTS.

FORMAT: All contestants will play 18 holes stroke play on Monday, July 12th. The players with the lowest 32 scores will advance to match play on Tuesday at 7:30am. In the event of a tie for the last qualifying spot, there will be a hole-by-hole play-off beginning immediately after the last stipulated round played on Monday. The play-off will begin on the 1st hole, followed by the 2nd, 3rd, 13th, 14th, etc. All other ties will be decided by a blind draw.

There will be two matches on Tuesday & Wednesday. The finals will be 18 holes on Thursday at 8am. Matches will start on Tuesday at 7:30am & 8am on Wednesday & Thursday.

TEES: Play will be from the CSGA Blue tees.

HOLE LOCATIONS: The hole locations on the greens will be indicated by sections that will change each day.

DISTANCE MEASURING DEVICES: Devices that measure distance ONLY are permitted. See CSGA Local Rules for restrictions on these devices.

STONE WALLS: All on course stone walls are considered integral parts of the golf course. (no free relief)

CONDITIONS: Per the Letter to Contestants, players are reminded that the following are in effect:

Dress Code, Footwear, Cellular Phones
Any questions, please ask at the reception table or at the starters table.

POWER LINES: If a ball strikes the power lines or poles at the 7th or 12th hole, the player must disregard that stroke, abandon the ball and play another ball as nearly as possible at the spot from which the original ball was played in accordance with Rule 20-5. No penalty.

7th HOLE: For a ball in water hazard of tee, as an additional option, there is a drop area on the lower tee.

PACE OF PLAY: The CSGA pace of Play Guidelines will strictly enforced. It is the players responsibility to know how their group stands with the time on their scorecard & with regards to the position of the group in front of them.

LUNCH & BEVERAGES: Lunch will be provided by the CSGA each day on the patio. The snack bar, located near the 4th & 12th tees, will be open on a cash basis.
