General Information:

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the USGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

Schedule of Events & Format:

Wednesday, June 29, 2022 – Qualifying (36 Holes of stroke play)

Grouping & Starting Times:

Starting times begin at 7:30am for round one and 12:30pm for round two.

Qualifying Positions & Playoff:

The players advancing will be posted on the day of the qualifier. There will also be two (2) alternate positions available. Should you qualify, you must accept your position and pick up the proper credentials prior to leaving the qualifying site. In the event of any tie for the last qualifying place or any of the alternate positions, the players concerned shall compete in a sudden death play-off to begin immediately following the conclusion of round two.

Registration:

When you arrive at the club, please check in at the reception table located in front of the golf shop.

Practice Round:

Practice rounds are available weekdays at a cost of \$40 (\$50 w/cart), weekends \$65 (\$79 w/cart) and weekends after 2PM \$50 (\$64 w/cart). Call the Pro shop (860) 928-7748 for available tee time.

Practice Range:

The practice range will be open beginning at 6:30am. Range balls are compliments of Connecticut National Golf Club.

Course Setup:

Connecticut National Golf Course will play as a par 71 at approximately 6,960 yards with a time par of 4 hours and 29 minutes.

Caddies:

The use of a caddie is permitted. Connecticut National Golf Club does not have any club caddies available.

Automotive Transportation & Pull Carts

The use of a golf cart during any round is prohibited. The use of a push/pull cart is permitted.

Driver Heads, Groove Specifications & Golf Balls:

Model Local Rules G-1, G-3 & G-3 are in effect.

One Ball Rule:-

Model Local Rule G-4 is in effect. During an entire round, each ball at which the player makes a stroke must be the same brand and model as found in a single entry on the current List of Conforming Golf Balls.

Pace of Play:

The pace of play policy as adopted by the Connecticut State Golf Association will be in effect.

Attire:

Proper golf attire is required by players, caddies and spectators. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

Footwear:

Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during the stipulated round. Penalty for breach of this condition is disqualification.

Withdrawals:

You must contact the USGA Championship Department at (908) 234-2300 or the CSGA at (860) 257-4171 if you must withdraw from this qualifier. A competitor who fails to notify either the USGA or CSGA of his withdrawal may be subject to disciplinary actions by the USGA.
