



## Qualifying – 2022 US Senior Women’s Amateur

### **General Information:**

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the USGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

### **Format & Qualifying Positions:**

18 holes of stroke play qualifying. The players with the low two (2) scores will advance to the Championship. There will also be two (2) alternate positions available.

Should you qualify, you must accept your position and pick up the proper credentials prior to leaving the qualifying site. Any ties for the last qualifying position or alternate positions will be determined by a sudden-death playoff beginning immediately after the conclusion of play.

### **Schedule of Events:**

Monday, June 27, 2022 – Qualifying Round (18 Holes)

### **Grouping & Starting Times:**

Starting times will begin at 1:20pm from the 1st tee.

### **Practice Round:**

Practice rounds are available at The Club at River Oaks at varying dates and times. To schedule a practice round please contact a member of The Club at River Oaks professional staff at (860) 354-3330.

### **Registration:**

When you arrive at the Club, please check in at the reception table, located near the Golf Shop.

### **Practice Range:**

The practice range will be available for your use beginning at 6:30am and is courtesy of the CSGA.

### **Course Setup:**

The Club at River Oaks will play as a par 71 at approximately 5,600 yards with a time par of 4 hours and 28 minutes. For practice round purposes players should play the gold tees.

### **Food & Beverage:**

There will be no food and beverage service available at the Club at River Oaks on the day of qualifying.

### **Attire:**

Proper golf attire is required at all times by players, caddies and spectators. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

### **Footwear:**

Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during the stipulated round. See Model Local Rule G-7 in Section 8 of the Official Guide to the Rules of Golf.

***Caddies & Transportation:***

A player may carry her own bag, employ a caddie or use a golf cart. There are no club caddies available at The Club at River Oaks. Players and caddies must walk at all times during the stipulated round. The use of push/pull cart is permitted. A player is not required to employ a caddie for any stage of the Championship

***Note Regarding Transportation:***

The USGA "One Seat" policy is in effect. A player and their caddie are not permitted to ride in a golf cart at the same time during the round.

***Driver Heads & Golf Balls:***

Only brands of golf balls on the most current List of Conforming Golf Balls and driver heads on the most current List of Conforming Driver Heads may be used. Updated lists may be found on the USGA website at [www.usga.org](http://www.usga.org) or by contacting the USGA Equipment Standards Department at (908) 234-2300. See Model Local Rules G-1 and G-3.

***Limitation on Golf Balls:***

The one ball Rule as prescribed in Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. See Model Local Rule G-4.

***Groove Specifications Condition:***

In Sectional qualifying and in the Championship proper, the Local Rule as prescribed by Section 8 of the Committee Procedures is in effect. Model Local Rule G-2.

***Withdrawals:***

You must contact the USGA Championship Department at (908) 234-2300 or the CSGA at (860) 257-4171 if you must withdraw from this qualifier. A competitor who fails to notify either the USGA or CSGA of her withdrawal may be subject to disciplinary actions by the USGA.
