

35th Connecticut Mid-Amateur Championship



Country Club of New Canaan August 23-24, 2022

Please read the information below carefully as several changes have been made to CSGA standard operating procedures in order to ensure a safe environment for all competitors, host staff, volunteers, and CSGA staff.

General Information:

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the CSGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

Schedule of Events:

Tuesday, August 23rd – 18 holes of stroke play. Players with the low 36 scores, including ties, will advance. Wednesday, August 24th – 36 holes of stroke play. The player with the lowest 54-hole total will be declared champion.

Registration:

Players must check in at the player registration table located outside the golf shop upon their arrival.

Practice Rounds:

The Country Club of New Canaan is offering a complimentary practice round on most Tuesdays, Wednesdays, Thursdays and at limited times on Friday mornings. To schedule a practice round please contact Caddie Master, Chuck Clark via email at cclark@ccofnewcanaan.org.

Practice Range:

The practice range will be available for use beginning at 6:30am each day. Players MUST not hit a shot over the fence. Any violation of this club regulation may result in loss of range access

Caddies & Push Carts:

The use of a caddie is permitted. The Country Club of New Canaan has a limited number of caddies available. To reserve a club caddie please contact Chuck Clark via email at cclark@ccofnewcanaan.org. The use of a push cart is permitted.

Golf Carts:

There are an extremely limited number of carts due to a shortage of rental carts. It is highly recommended that players walk throughout the championship. If necessary, a player will be permitted to use a golf cart but will be required to share.

Course Setup:

The Country Club of New Canaan will play as a par 70 at approximately 6,350 yards with a time par of 4 hours and 26 minutes.

Food & Beverage:

Lunch will be available to all contestants each day. Lunch hours will be limited to the hours of 11am-3pm on Monday. Lunch will be available for all players between rounds two and three. The cost of the lunch is included in your entry fee.



Attire:

Proper golf attire is required at all times by players, caddies and spectators. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

Footwear:

Rule 4.3a is modified in this way: During a round, a player must not wear shots with traditional spikes (that is, spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground (regardless of whether made of metal, ceramic, plastic, or other materials)) or spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course.

Trophies & Prizes:

The Champion will have his name engraved on the permanent Connecticut Mid-Amateur Championship trophy. The champion and runner-up will receive a keepsake replica trophy. Additionally, low finishers will receive merchandise credit redeemable at the Country Club of New Canaan. Ties for any other position other than Champion will be decided by round three score first, and then as follows until the tie is broken: the combination of rounds two and three, the back nine of round three, the last six holes of round three, the last three holes of round three and the final hole of round three.

Withdrawals:

You must contact the CSGA at (860) 257-4171 if you must withdraw from this championship. A competitor who fails to notify the CSGA of his withdrawal may be subject to disciplinary actions.
