



77th Connecticut Senior Amateur Championship

Country Club of Waterbury
October 3-4, 2022



General Information:

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the USGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

Schedule of Events:

Monday, October 3rd – 18 holes of stroke play. Cut to the low 39 scores (including ties).
Tuesday, October 4th – 18 holes of stroke play.

Play-Off & Ties:

In the event of a tie for the championship, there will be a sudden death hole by hole playoff immediately following the conclusion of round two.

Practice Round:

Practice rounds are available on a limited basis. The cost of a practice round is \$35 plus tax. Arrangements can be made by contacting a member of the professional staff at (203) 756-6644.

Course Setup:

The Country Club of Waterbury will play to a par 69 at approximately 6,200 yards with a time par of 4 hours and 26 minutes. A copy of the championship course setup is provided via the following link: [2022 Senior Amateur Championship Setup](#)

Registration:

Players must check in at the player registration table located in front of the golf shop upon their arrival.

Practice Range:

The practice range will be available for use beginning one hour prior to play each day. The practice range at the Country Club of Waterbury is located at the back end of the property and takes approximately 5 minutes via shuttle. Please take this into consideration when planning your arrival time.

Caddies & Transportation:

The use of a golf cart is permitted but not mandatory. Due to a shortage of rental carts, the CSGA requests that, if possible, you walk during round one on Monday, October 3rd. Caddies are permitted but may be required to walk.

Attire:

Proper golf attire is required at all times by players, caddies and spectators. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

Footwear:

Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during the stipulated round. Driver Heads & Golf Balls:

Only brands of golf balls on the most current List of Conforming Golf Balls and driver heads on the most current List of Conforming Driver Heads may be used. Updated lists may be found on the USGA website at www.usga.org or by contacting the USGA Equipment Standards Department at (908) 234-2300. See Model Local Rules G-1 and G-3.

Food & Beverage:

Lunch will be provided for contestants each day of the Championship and is included in your entry fee.

Trophies & Prizes:

The winner will have his name engraved on the permanent Connecticut Senior Amateur trophy. The winner and runner-up will also receive a replica trophy. Also, low finishers will receive merchandise credit redeemable at the Country Club of Waterbury golf shop. Ties for any position other than Champion will be decided by round two total first then by a match of cards using round two.

Withdrawals:

You must contact the CSGA at (860) 257-4171 if you must withdraw from this championship. A competitor who fails to notify the CSGA of his withdrawal may be subject to disciplinary actions.
