General Information: The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the USGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

Scoring: In addition to the official paper scorecards, the CSGA requests that one member of each foursome uses the Golf Genius mobile app to enter hole-by-hole scores throughout the day.

Format: Round One – Four-Ball (18-holes) Round Two – Foursomes, selected drive alternate shot (18-holes)

Practice Round: Practice rounds are available to those competitors in this championship only on weekday afternoons on a limited basis. The cost for a practice round will be \$40, includes the use of a cart and must be paid by **cash only, no credit cards will be accepted**. Arrangements may be made by calling the Black Hall Club golf shop at (860) 434-2038.

Caddies: Players are prohibited from using a caddie during any round.

Registration: Players must check in at the player registration table located in front of the golf shop upon their arrival.

Practice Range: The practice range will be available for your use beginning at 6:45am.

Golf Carts: The use of a golf cart is mandatory and included as part of your entry fee. Only one cart will be permitted per team.

Attire: Proper golf attire is always required by players, caddies and spectators. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner. Also, Rule 4.3a is modified in this way: Players may not wear shoes with metal spikes.

Food & Beverage: Lunch will be served in the clubhouse between rounds. Cocktails and hors d'oeuvres will be served following play.

Ties: In the event of a tie for champion, there will be a hole-by-hole playoff immediately following the conclusion of all rounds beginning on Hole #10 using alternate shot (selected drive) format. Ties for merchandise credit will be determined by round two score first, then by matching round two scorecards by using holes 10-18, 13-18, 16-18, and hole 18. Ties for Dick Tettelbach Player of the Year points will be shared and split among all those involved except for the champion.

Withdrawals: You must contact the CSGA at (860) 257-4171 if you must withdraw from this championship. A competitor who fails to notify the CSGA of his withdrawal may be subject to disciplinary actions.
