

17th Connecticut Senior Match Play

Player Registration:

Players should check in at the player registration table located on the porch near the golf shop entrance upon arrival at the club.

General Information:

The Rules of Golf govern play. This information sheet, the CSGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

Schedule of Events:

Monday, June 26th – 18 holes of stroke play. The low 32 scores will advance to match play. In the event of a tie for the last match play qualifier, there will be a sudden death playoff immediately following the round.

Tuesday, June 27th – Round of 32 and Round of 16 matches.

Wednesday, June 28th – Quarterfinals & Semifinals

Thursday, June 29th – Finals

All matches will be contested over 18-holes.

Practice Rounds:

Practice rounds are available on Mondays-Thursdays in the afternoon on a limited basis. The cost for a practice round will be \$40, includes the use of a cart and must be paid by cash only, no credit cards will be accepted. Arrangements may be made by calling the Black Hall Club golf shop at (860) 434-2038.

Practice Range:

The practice range will be available for use approximately one hour prior to the first starting time. The cost of the range is included in the entry fee.

Golf Carts:

The use of a golf cart is mandatory and included in your entry fee.

Caddies:

The use of a caddie during stroke play qualifying is prohibited. Caddies are permitted during match play rounds. When opponents are required to share a golf cart the presence of a caddie will not change the number of carts permitted per match.

Attire:

Proper golf attire is required. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

Footwear:

Model Local Rule G-7 is in effect.

Driver Heads & Golf Balls:

Model Local Rules G-1 and G-3 are in effect.

Food & Beverage:

Lunch will be provided for contestants each day of the Championship and is included in your entry fee.

Trophies & Prizes:

The winner will have his name engraved on the permanent Connecticut Senior Match Play trophy. Champion through quarterfinalist finishers will receive merchandise credit redeemable at Black Hall Club.

Withdrawals:

You must contact the CSGA at (860) 257-4171 if you must withdraw from this championship. A competitor who fails to notify the CSGA of his withdrawal may be subject to disciplinary actions.
