



82nd Connecticut Junior Amateur Championship

Fairview Farm Golf Course

Harwinton, Connecticut

July 10 -13, 2023

General Information:

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the CSGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

Schedule of Events:

Monday, July 10th – 18 holes of stroke play. The low 32 scores advance to match play. There will be a playoff to determine last spot(s) if necessary.

Tuesday, July 11th – Round of 32 matches

Wednesday, July 12th – Round of 16 matches (am) and quarterfinal matches (pm)

Thursday, July 13th – Semifinal matches (am) and Final Match (pm)

Practice Round:

Practice Rounds are available at Fairview Farm published rates and times.

Registration:

Players must check in at the player registration table located outside the entrance to the golf shop upon their arrival.

Practice Range:

The practice range will be available beginning one hour prior to play each day and is included in your entry fee.

Caddies & Transportation:

All players are required to walk at all times during this championship. Players may either carry their bag or use their own push/pull cart. Motorized golf carts or caddies are not permitted. Spectators carts will not be allowed during this championship. Players are not permitted to use a caddie during any tournament round.

Attire:

Proper golf attire is required at all times by players, caddies and spectators. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

Footwear:

Rule 4.3a is modified in this way: During a round, a player must not wear shoes with traditional spikes (that is, spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground (regardless of whether made of metal, ceramic, plastic, or other materials)) or spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course.

Course Setup: Fairview Farm Golf Club will play as a par 72 at approximately 6,600 yards with a time par of 4 hours and 20 minutes.

Play-Off & Ties:

Any ties for the last spot(s) in the match play bracket will be decided by a hole-by-hole playoff immediately after the final group has completed play. It is the responsibility of the player to be ready to play when the playoff is set to begin. Players who are not present when the playoff is set to begin will forfeit their spot. All ties for match play seeding are broken by return of card sequence.
