



Qualifier – 2023 Connecticut Mid-Amateur

General Information:

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the CSGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

Schedule of Events:

Wednesday, August 9th, 2023 – Qualifying Round, 18 holes stroke play.

Qualifying Positions:

Players with the **low 16 scores, plus ties**, will advance to the 2023 Connecticut Mid-Amateur Championship.

Grouping & Starting Times:

Starting times begin at 7:30am from the first tee.

Practice Round:

Practice rounds are very limited. The cost of a practice round will be \$45 plus \$30 for a cart. To schedule a practice round, please call the Redding CC Golf Shop at (203)938-9832.

Registration:

Players must check in at the player registration table located in front of the golf shop upon their arrival.

Practice Range:

The practice range will be available for your use beginning at 6:30am. Please note that the range is strictly **irons only**. Please use the limited flight balls that will be available.

Caddies & Transportation:

A player may carry his own bag, employ a caddie, or use a golf cart. While the use of a golf cart is permitted during the qualifier, the cost is not included in your entry fee. If you wish to utilize a golf cart, please check in with the Golf Shop upon your arrival. **The cost of the cart will be \$30 per player and must be paid in cash.**

Attire:

Proper golf attire is required at all times by players, caddies and spectators. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

Footwear:

Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during the stipulated round. Penalty for breach of this condition is disqualification.

Food & Beverage:

Food and beverage, **on a cash basis only**, is available. Players, caddies, and spectators are responsible for any food and beverage fees incurred during their round.

Driver Heads & Golf Balls:

The optional conditions as prescribed in Appendix I of the Rules of Golf are in effect.

Withdrawals:

You must contact the CSGA at (860) 257-4171 if you must withdraw from this qualifier. A competitor who fails to notify the CSGA of his withdrawal may be subject to disciplinary actions by the CSGA.
