



78th Connecticut Senior Amateur Championship

Silver Spring Country Club
October 2-3, 2023



General Information:

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the USGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

Schedule of Events:

Monday, October 2nd – 18 holes of stroke play. Cut to the low 39 scores (including ties).
Tuesday, October 3rd – 18 holes of stroke play. 10:00am shotgun start.

Play-Off & Ties:

In the event of a tie for the championship, there will be a sudden death hole by hole playoff immediately following the conclusion of round two.

Practice Round:

Practice rounds are available on Tuesday, September 26th, Wednesday, September 27th & Thursday, September 28th after 1:00pm. The cost of a practice round is \$35 and must be paid via cash or check. Arrangements can be made by contacting a member of the professional staff at (203) 438-0100.

Course Setup:

Silver Spring Country Club will play to a par 71 at approximately 6,250 yards with a time par of 4 hours and 34 minutes. For practice round purposes, players should play the Blue tees.

Registration:

Players must check in at the player registration table located near the bag drop upon their arrival.

Practice Range:

The practice range will be available for use beginning one hour prior to play each day and is included in your entry fee.

Caddies & Transportation:

The use of a double rider golf cart is mandatory. Caddies are permitted but may be required to walk.

Attire:

Proper golf attire is required at all times by players, caddies and spectators. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

Footwear:

Shoes with traditionally-designed spikes (regardless of composition, i.e., ceramic, plastic, etc.) or spikes, regardless of design, comprised either entirely or partially of metal (if such metal may come in contact with the course) are prohibited during the stipulated round. See Model Local Rule G-7. In addition, players are not permitted to change shoes in the parking lot. Please use the locker room facilities that will be available throughout the day.

Driver Heads & Golf Balls:

Only brands of golf balls on the most current List of Conforming Golf Balls and driver heads on the most current List of Conforming Driver Heads may be used. Updated lists may be found on the USGA website at www.usga.org or by contacting the USGA Equipment Standards Department at (908) 234-2300. See Model Local Rules G-1 and G-3.

Food & Beverage:

A boxed lunch will be provided to contestants on day one and a buffet lunch during the awards presentation will follow on day two. A cash bar will be available on day two.

Trophies & Prizes:

The winner will have his name engraved on the permanent Connecticut Senior Amateur trophy. The winner and runner-up will also receive a replica trophy. Also, low finishers will receive merchandise credit redeemable at Silver Spring Country Club. Ties for any position other than Champion will be decided by round two total first then by a match of cards using round two.

Withdrawals:

You must contact the CSGA at (860) 257-4171 if you must withdraw from this championship. A competitor who fails to notify the CSGA of his withdrawal may be subject to disciplinary actions.
