NOTICE TO PLAYERS

This notice to players supplements the CSGA Local Rules and Conditions of Competitions, which may be found on the Country Club of Farmington One Day tournament portal.

PACE OF PLAY: The CSGA Pace of Play policy will be in effect for this One Day event. Players are expected to complete their round in 4 and a half hours. Please play "ready golf" as outlined in the 2023 Rules of Golf and always keep in position with the group in front of you, not behind.

FORMAT: 18-hole stroke play with gross and net competitions in both divisions, Tettelbach (Open) and Siderowf (Senior).

FLIGHTS: Players age fifty-five (55) and older are competing in the Siderowf (Senior) division with the remaining players in the Tettelbach (Open) division.

TEES: Tettelbach (Open) Division – **Black Tees**
Siderowf (Senior) Division – **Blue Tees or Green Tees** – Net Only Competition

SCORING: Scoring will be done through the Golf Genius Mobile Scoring App. All players must proceed to the patio area immediately after the completion of play to verbally certify your score with a member of the CSGA staff. This verbal process is equivalent to signing your scorecard and is necessary to avoid disqualification.

OUT OF BOUNDS: Identified or defined by boundary fences, white stakes and/or lines on the following holes: # 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 16, 17 & 18. When both stakes and lines are present, stakes identify the boundary and lines define the boundary. Any ball that comes to rest on or over Waterville Road is considered out of bounds even if it comes to rest on another area of the golf course.

HOLE #9: As an additional option for a ball coming to rest in the parking lot behind the 9th green, players may elect to use the nearest of two drop zones located to the right and left of the green.

HOLE #17: The maintenance barn and parking lot/cart path area adjacent to the maintenance barn is out of bounds.

PENALTY AREAS: Identified by yellow or red stakes and/or lines on the following holes: #4, 5, 6, 7, 9, 11, 12, 13, 14 & 17. When both stakes and lines are present, stakes identify the penalty area and lines define the penalty area. Penalty relief is available as described in Rule 17-1.

IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTIONS CLOSE TO PUTTING GREEN: Model Local Rule F-5 is in effect. For a ball in the general area a player may take relief under Rule 16.1f if an immovable obstruction is on the line of play, within two club-lengths of the putting green and two club-lengths of the ball.

GROUND UNDER REPAIR: Areas defined by white lines on the ground are Ground Under Repair. Free relief is available as prescribed in Rule 16-1.

NO PLAY ZONES: Decorative flower beds are No Play Zones from which play is prohibited and *free relief is mandatory* as described in Rule 16-1.

PRIZES: Top finishers in each division will receive merchandise credit redeemable at the The Little Red Golf Shop at the Country Club of Farmington. Additionally, the top five finishers in each division will qualify to be eligible for the season ending One Day Championship at Lake of Isles on October 10th.

ONE DAY PLAYER OF THE YEAR SPONSORED BY CHRIS COTE'S GOLF SHOP: The top fifteen finishers in the Tettelbach and Siderowf divisions will earn One Day Tournament Player of the Year points. One Day Players may accumulate points in both the gross and net divisions. The top three finishers in each division at the end of the year will receive merchandise credit redeemable at Chris Cote's Golf Shop in Portland or Southington, Conn.
