

## 83<sup>rd</sup> Connecticut Junior Amateur Championship

Watertown Golf Club, Watertown, Connecticut July, 8-11, 2024

#### **General Information:**

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the CSGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

## Schedule of Events:

Monday, July  $8^{th} - 18$  holes of stroke play. The low 32 scores advance to match play. There will be a playoff to determine last spot(s) if necessary.

Tuesday, July 9<sup>th</sup> – Round of 32 Matches (AM) and Round of 16 Matches (PM)

Wednesday, July 10<sup>th</sup> – Quarterfinal Matches (AM) and Semifinal Matches (PM)

Thursday, July 11<sup>th</sup> – Final Match (AM)

## Practice Round:

Practice Rounds are available in the afternoon on Saturday, July 6<sup>th</sup> and Sunday, July 7<sup>th</sup> after 4PM for **players only** and all players are required to walk during the practice round. To schedule your practice round, you must call the Watertown GC Golf Shop at (860) 274-4387.

## Registration:

Players must check in at the player registration table located on the patio next to the putting green upon their arrival.

## Practice Range:

The practice range will be available beginning one hour prior to play each day and is included in your entry fee.

## Caddies & Transportation:

All players are required to walk at all times during this championship. Players may either carry their bag or use their own push/pull cart. Motorized golf carts or caddies are not permitted, and there will be no spectator carts allowed during this championship. Players are not permitted to use a caddie during any tournament round.

#### Attire

Proper golf attire is required at all times by players, caddies and spectators. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

**Course Setup:** Watertown Golf Club will play as a par 71 at approximately 6,400 yards with a time par of 4 hours and 20 minutes.

## Footwear:

Rule 4.3a is modified in this way: During a round, a player must not wear shots with traditional spikes (that is, spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground (regardless of whether made of metal, ceramic, plastic, or other materials)) or spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course.

## Play-Off & Ties:

Any ties for the last spot(s) in the match play bracket will be decided by a hole-by-hole playoff beginning on Hole #1 immediately after the final group has completed play. It is the responsibility of the player to be ready to play at the scoreboard area when the playoff is set to begin. Players who are not present when the playoff is set to begin will forfeit their spot. All ties for match play seeding are broken by return of card sequence.

## Trophies & Prizes:

The winner will have his name engraved on the permanent Junior Amateur Championship Trophy. All players advancing to the Quarterfinals will also receive merchandise certificates redeemable at the Watertown GC Golf Shop.
