



Golf Club of Avon July 1, 2024

General Information:

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the CSGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

Schedule of Events:

Monday July 1, 2024– Qualifying Round (18 holes of stroke play)

Qualifying Positions:

90th Connecticut Open: Players with the low 12 scores, including ties, will advance. 37th Connecticut Mid-Amateur: Players with the low 18 scores, including ties, will advance.

Grouping & Starting Times:

Starting times will begin at 7:30am from the first tee.

Practice Round:

The Golf Club of Avon is offering practice rounds to competitors only on a first come basis based on availability on the following dates and times: June 25th – after 11am, June 26th – after 11am and June 30th – after 2pm.

Competitors are reminded to always adhere to the Golf Club of Avon's dress code and guest policies. The full policy can be found on the club website via the following link: <u>GCA GUEST GUIDELINES</u>

The cost of a practice round is \$60 per player and MUST be paid via cash or check. The fee includes the use of a cart and practice facility. In addition, players may carry their own bag, bring their own push cart, or rent a push cart from the club. Caddies are permitted during practice rounds but may not play the golf course.

Players must check in at the golf shop upon arrival. Access to the practice facility is restricted to one hour prior to the practice round starting time. The clubhouse, including the locker room and food & amp; beverage will not be available during practice rounds. The Golf Club of Avon does have yardage books for sale in the golf shop.

Course Setup:

The Golf Club of Avon Red/White course will play as a par 71 at approximately 6,600 yards with a time par of 4 hours and 26 minutes.

Registration:

Players must check in at the player registration table located in front of the golf shop upon their arrival.

Practice Range:

The driving range will be available to players beginning at 6:30am. Range balls are compliments of the CSGA.

Caddies:

A player may carry his own bag or employ a caddie. Players are responsible any fee incurred for the use of a caddie. Players are entitled to employ a caddie and use a golf cart with the only restriction being that of the cart limitation outlined in the "Golf Carts" section of this notice.

Golf Carts:

The use of a cart is permitted but not included in your entry fee. Each starting time is limited to one cart for two riders or two carts for three riders. The cost of a golf cart will be \$30 and must be paid **<u>BY</u> CASH ONLY** in the golf shop.

Food & Beverage:

The on-course snack bar will be available for cash purchases.

Attire:

Proper golf attire is required at all times by players, caddies and spectators. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans of all kinds, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

Footwear:

Rule 4.3a is modified in this way: During a round, a player must not wear shoes with traditional spikes (that is, spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground (regardless of whether made of metal, ceramic, plastic, or other materials)) or spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course.

Driver Heads & Golf Balls:

Local Rule G-1 and G-3 are in effect. A player must not make a stroke with a clubhead or golf ball that is not on the current listing of the USGA List of Conforming Driver Heads or List of Conforming Golf Balls. Penalty for breach of this Rule is disqualification.

Withdrawals:

You must contact the CSGA at (860) 257-4171 if you must withdraw from this championship. A competitor who fails to notify the CSGA of his withdrawal may be subject to disciplinary actions.
