General Rules Information:

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the CSGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

Schedule of Events:

Monday, August 26, 2024 – 18 holes of stroke play. Shotgun start to begin at 9am. This event has both a gross and net competition and all competitors will compete in both. In the event of a tie for the Championship, a hole-by-hole playoff will begin immediately following the conclusion of all rounds for the Gross division champion only. All other ties will be broken by a match of cards.

Practice Round:

Practice rounds are available at the Longshore Golf Course published rates and times.

Course Setup:

Longshore Golf Course will play as a par 69 at approximately 5,900 yards. Players may play from the Longshore BLUE tees for practice round purposes. Please note these yardages may be subject to change.

Registration:

Players must check in at the player registration table located near the golf shop.

Practice Range:

The use of the practice facilities is included in your entry fee and will be available for use beginning at 8:00am. The range is limited to 150 yards.

Caddies & Transportation:

The use of a golf cart is **Mandatory**. The cost of a golf cart is included in your entry fee.

Attire:

Proper golf attire is required at all times. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

Footwear:

Rule 4.3a is modified in this way: During a round, a player must not wear shoes with traditional spikes (that is, spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground (regardless of whether made of metal, ceramic, plastic, or other materials)) or spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course.

Driver Heads & Golf Balls:

Local Rules G-1 and G-3 are in effect.
