CSGA COMPETITIVE FAIRNESS GENDER POLICY

Effective beginning the 2025 CSGA Championship season

The Connecticut State Golf Association, commonly referred to as CSGA, is an allied golf association of the USGA. In regards to policies involving gender, the CSGA hereby adopts the eligibility criteria set forth in Sections 1, 2, 3, 4, 9, 10, 11, 13d, 14 and 16 of the <u>USGA's Competitive Fairness Gender Policy</u>; provided, however, that:

- Where the term "USGA" is used, the term shall be replaced with "CSGA"
- Where the term "Championship" is used, the term shall be replaced with "all CSGA competitions".
- Where the term "USGA Team" is used, the term shall be replaced with "CSGA Team" and include any team selected by the CSGA to represent either the CSGA or the state of Connecticut in regional, national or international competitions.
- The CSGA does not currently have an Anti-Doping policy in place, so any references to doping are hereby expressly omitted.

The CSGA expressly reserves the right to modify this Policy at any time, in its sole discretion, with or without notice.
