General Information:

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the United States Golf Association govern play. This information sheet, the CSGA Hard Card and any site-specific Local Rules and Conditions of Competition sheets are supplements to the Rules of Golf. Local Rules of the host course do not apply.

Schedule of Events:

Monday, August 11, 2025 – 18 holes of stroke play. The low **11** players and ties will advance to the Championship.

Practice Round:

Practice rounds are available at Blackledge published rates and times.

Registration:

Players must check in at the player registration table located outside the golf shop upon their arrival.

Course Setup:

Blackledge Country Club (Andersons Glen) will play as a par 72 at approximately 6,400 yards. Players may play from the Blackledge BLUE tees for practice round purposes. Please note these yardages may be subject to change.

Practice Range:

The use of the practice facilities is included in your entry fee.

Caddies & Transportation:

The use of a golf cart is not mandatory but players may purchase a golf cart in the golf shop.

Attire:

Proper golf attire is required at all times. Shorts must be Bermuda length. Shirts must have a collar and be tucked in. Jeans, cargo pants/shorts, tee shirts and tank tops are prohibited. Hats must be worn in a traditional manner.

Footwear:

Rule 4.3a is modified in this way: During a round, a player must not wear shoes with traditional spikes (that is, spikes having single or multiple points designed to penetrate deeply into the surface of the ground (regardless of whether made of metal, ceramic, plastic, or other materials) or spikes of any design that are entirely or partially made of metal, if such metal may come in contact with the course.

Driver Heads & Golf Balls:

Local Rules G-1 and G-3 are in effect.

Withdrawals:

You must contact the CSGA at (860) 257-4171 if you must withdraw from this championship. A competitor who fails to notify the CSGA of his withdrawal may be subject to disciplinary actions.
